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#### **Summary**

Except where noted, all fees have been administratively revised for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate of 3.6% as of February 2018.

Recreation and Park Fees were adopted by the City Council in November 2017 and were effective January 2018 except where noted. These fees were not adjusted for the CPI.

Affordable Housing and Development Impact Fees were increased by the Construction Cost index for a 1 year period from April 2017 through April 2018 at the rate of 2.7%.

No change in Library fees.

The Rent Stabilization Program fee was adopted by the City Council by Resolution # 15388 on June 5, 2018 and is effective July 1,2018.

Added late fees to Rent Stabilization Program.

Additionally, the City will pass-through to the applicant any discrete costs incurred from the use of external service providers if required to process the specific application.
