On the New Member Access Page, login with the following information and complete the Request form.

Complete Request Form and go to Profile page. When you set up your login (e-mail address) and password, remember to make a note of it because you'll need it to register in the following years.

Complete Profile then click the "Continue to Waiver" link.

Click "Continue to Waiver" at the bottom of the page. At the bottom of the waiver, check the box stating you've read and agree with the Liability Waiver. Type your name (e-sign) in the Signature block and Submit. When you have completed the registration satisfactorily, you'll get a message thanking you for joining in 2013 and reminding you to pay your CDBA (\$120) and ADF dues (\$30) via the Team Snap "Pay Pal" option (preferred), credit card swipe (at practice) or check payable to ADF. No cash please.

If you don't receive a confirmation message, go back to the Membership page and look at your current on-line waiver. If it's dated 2013, you're good to go. If not, please try again. It's a little tweaky, so give me a call if you're still having trouble and we can walk through it together.
