
Species: Ulmus Americana- American Elm

Recommendation: Removal – DED Hazard


Summary:

The tree is infected with Dutch Elm Disease (DED) a rapidly spreading pathogen and poses an immediate hazard to other trees. There is no cure for the vascular disease. The tree is diseased and should be removed. There is no urgent safety threat. The tree was inspected on July 10, 2013.
