Recommendation: Removal – Dead Tree


Summary:

The demise of the tree was due to armillaria vascular disease. Fanned mycelium was found under the tree bark around the tree flare and trunk. There is no cure for the vascular disease. The tree is dead and should be removed. There is no urgent safety threat. The tree was inspected on August 5, 2013.
