### **TREE REMOVAL NOTICE**

The Eucalyptus (4), Pine (1), Acacia (1) and Pear (1) trees located on the vacant lot on the northeast corner of Buena Vista Avenue and Hibbard Street are proposed for removal in accordance with Chapter XXIII, Subsection 23.3, of the Alameda Municipal Code, and as approved by the Planning Board at its January 27, 2014 meeting. The trees will be removed after February 18, 2014.

The trees are being removed because they are in conflict with the approved site plan for the new Emergency Operations Center and Fire Station 3. New replacement trees will be planted in locations designated on the project plans.

Planning Board decisions can be appealed to the City Council within 10 days by filing a form in the Community Development Department at City Hall and paying the appropriate fee. Once an appeal is filed, a use cannot be established and a building permit cannot be issued until the City Council has conducted a public hearing and taken action on the appeal. Appeals shall be scheduled for public hearing by the City Council no later than the third regularly scheduled and held meeting following submittal of the appeal.
