

ATTENTION ALL MANAGERS:

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM MANAGER TO:

1. Complete and return the official application by due date listed.
2. Pay entry fees by due date listed.
3. Complete team roster properly by printing or typing.
4. Check website for team schedules and playing rules.
5. Notify team players and sponsors of insurance and liability.
6. Supply ARPD with Manager's current e-mail address.
7. Furnish ARPD with all required information regarding your address, city, zip and phone number; who your sponsor is and what your team name will be; the number of players on your team roster listing names, addresses, city, zip, phone numbers; and the total number of residents and non-residents.

TEAM INFORMATION

First preference is given to teams that were entered the previous year and in good standing. Teams must return their application with a \$100 deposit by FRIDAY July 29, 2016

METHOD OF SELECTION

After teams from the previous year have had their chance to reapply, the method and priority of acceptance of new teams will be: *FIRST*—those Alameda sponsored teams having at least 50 percent Alameda residents; *SECOND*—those teams with 75 percent of their players who are Alameda residents; thereafter, all other applicants as may be necessary to complete leagues. A minimum of 12 and a maximum of 20 persons is required on the official team roster.

WHERE AND WHEN ARE GAMES PLAYED?

League play will begin the week of *August 15, 2016* at *Leydecker, Upper/Lower Washington and Woodstock Parks.*

HOW MUCH IS THE ENTRY FEE FOR THE COED SOFTBALL SLO-PITCH LEAGUES?

- 10-Game Season:..... \$650 Resident Team
- \$700 Non-Resident Team
- 12-Game Season:..... \$700 Resident Team*
- \$750 Non-Resident Team*

Resident Team consists of 75 percent or more players who live in Alameda.
Non-Resident Team consists of 74 percent or less players who live in Alameda.

*12-Game/7 Team League will only be formed if necessary.

WHAT DOES THE ENTRY FEE PAY FOR?

Monies collected are used to pay for game balls, bases, lights, light replacement, umpires and league administration.

WHEN ARE ENTRY FEES AND ROSTERS DUE?

Once you have been officially accepted, the balance of your team entry fee will be due no later than MONDAY, August 15 2016 IN THE ARPD OFFICE. Your REMAINING BALANCE will be (less \$100 deposit):

- 10-Game Season: \$650 less \$100 deposit = \$550 Resident Team
\$700 less \$100 deposit = \$600 Non-Resident Team
- 12-Game Season: \$700 less \$100 deposit = \$600 Resident Team
\$750 less \$100 deposit = \$650 Non-Resident Team

Completed team rosters must be turned in at the first game.

FAILURE TO PAY LEAGUE FEES BY MONDAY, August 15,2016 WILL RESULT IN YOUR TEAM BEING DROPPED FROM THE SCHEDULE.

TEAM PLACEMENT

Team placement will be at the discretion of the League Coordinator.

CAN A PLAYER PLAY ON MORE THAN ONE TEAM?

YES! A player can play on as many teams as they want as long as they are not on the same nights.

CLASSIFICATION OF LEAGUES

Teams MUST complete the official application and nights and classification forms. If accepted, every effort will be made to place you in your top choices. If we are unable to do so, we will contact you as to other alternatives. THE DEPARTMENT TRIES TO PLACE TEAMS INTO LEAGUES ACCORDING TO AND COMMENSURATE WITH THEIR ABILITY.
