




Alameda Recreation and Park Department and Alameda Youth Committee presents

How to Participate!

Receive your pieces of the kindness puzzle in one of 3 ways!

- Name of organization and age group requesting pieces.
- Number of puzzle pieces needed. (Every effort will be made to fulfill all requests completely but pieces are limited. Please indicate a minimum and maximum number desired. Please return any unused pieces to ARPD ASAP).
- Indicate if you would like your pieces delivered on February 3rd and include delivery address (Alameda delivery only)

OR

- If you would like to pick-up your puzzle pieces at the ARPD office (orders available on or after Friday, February 3rd).

2) Stop by “The Piece and Kindness Campaign” tables at South Shore Center in front of Trabocco by the frog fountain on:

- Tuesday, February 14 from 4—6pm
- Friday, February 17 from 4—6pm
- Saturday, February 25 from 2—4pm

3) Stop by the ARPD office, 2226 Santa Clara Ave. and pick-up your piece (individuals only)
