

- **Alameda Point Antiques Faire**—the largest antiques show in Northern California, 1st Sunday of the month.
- **West End Flea Market**—Saturdays at the College of Alameda.
- **Friday Art Walk**—2nd Friday of each month.
- **Park Street Spring Festival**—Mother's Day weekend.
- **Sand Castle and Sand Sculpture Contest**—June happening at Crown Memorial State Beach.
- **Concerts at the Cove**—free summer concert series, 2nd Friday of June, July, and August.
- **Mayor's 4th of July Parade**—the largest Independence Day parade in the nation.
- **Park Street Art & Wine Faire**—last weekend of July.
- **Neptune Beach Community Celebration**—two-day weekend Webster Street festival, held in September.
- **Park Street Classic Car Show**—2nd Saturday in October.
- **Christmas Tree Lane**—annual Thompson Avenue tradition since 1938; 55 decorated houses with luminous winter dreamscape.
