Second Community Workshop for the Central Avenue/Third Street/Taylor Avenue Intersection

The Public Works Department, the Alameda Unified School District, and the Police Department invite the public to the second community meeting to discuss potential improvements to the five-legged Central Avenue/Third Street/Taylor Avenue intersection.


When: Thursday, May 30, 2013 at 7:00 p.m.

Where: Encinal High School Cafeteria (210 Central Avenue)

What: Potential options to modify the intersection at Central Avenue/Third Street/Taylor Avenue including:

- Improving student drop-off and pick-up.
- Closing Taylor Avenue to allow only right turns onto Third Street.
- Removing parking spaces on Taylor Avenue as well as Fourth Street.
- Converting Taylor Avenue to a one-way street toward Encinal High School.
- Restricting left turns from Central Avenue onto Third Street towards Santa Clara Avenue during student arrival and dismissal.
- Providing a pedestrian signal for the Central Avenue crosswalk at Encinal High School (long-term option).
