Community Meeting for Proposed Cross Alameda Trail Project along Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway

Public Works staff invites you to a community meeting to discuss the proposed Cross Alameda Trail project on Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway between Webster Street and Main Street.

When: Monday, July 28, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

Where: City Hall West (located in Alameda Point), 950 West Mall Square,
Conference Room 201

What: The proposed Cross Alameda Trail will run parallel to and south of Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway between Webster Street and Main Street in an abandoned railroad right-of-way, which is now owned by the City of Alameda and is about 70 feet wide. The proposed path is almost one mile long, and has the following components:

- Asphalt path;
- Decomposed granite jogging path;
- Connector paths to two intersecting streets: Fifth Street and West Campus Drive;
- Pedestrian, bicycle and ADA improvements as well as wayfinding signs at the intersecting streets; and

- Trees and a bioswale as landscaping and urban runoff control consistent with the City's Bay Friendly Landscaping requirements and the Urban Greening Plan.

This community meeting will be a working session that will include a review of a draft project concept.
