## Groundbreaking Ceremony for Shoreline Drive Bikeway

Community members are invited to attend the “Groundbreaking” Ceremony to celebrate the ensuing construction of the City’s new Shoreline Bikeway.

“This project will greatly improve the safety and enjoyment of cross town bicycling,” said Mayor Marie Gilmore. “It will also invite more community members to get on their bikes and enjoy the beautiful bay in Alameda.”

The new bikeway will include a buffered space between the bicyclists and the motorists. It will be one of the longest buffered bikeways – also known as cycle tracks or protected bike lanes – in the San Francisco Bay Area.
