Team Registration and Fee Information

When does registration start?

Registration for ALL teams will start on **Monday December 22, 2014**. All teams must return their application and all team fees by **Friday, February 13, 2015**.

What teams are eligible to register?

Any team, regardless of residency status, can register to play in the Alameda Recreation and Park Department's Adult Basketball League. However, certain teams will have to pay a slightly higher non-residency rate. See rate information below.

How much is the entry fee?

For a six (6) team league - **10 games plus playoffs: \$650 per resident team: \$700 non-resident team.** Resident teams consist of 75% or more players who live in Alameda. Non-resident teams consist of 74% or less who live in Alameda. Includes up to 8 team jerseys.

What determines residency and non-residency?

Resident teams consist of 75% or more players who live in Alameda. Non-resident teams consist of 74% or less who live in Alameda.

When are rosters due?

Team rosters must be turned in at the first game.

League play dates:

League play begins on **Sunday, February 22 – May 10**
(No Basketball Game on Easter Sunday)

How old must a player be to participate?

All players must be a minimum of 18 years old and out of high school

It is the responsibility of the team manager to:

1. Complete and return the official application to the Alameda Recreation and Park Department, 2226 Santa Clara Avenue, Alameda, CA 94501 by due date listed. We need your current e-mail address in order for us to send league information, updated rules, etc. Please be sure to include your current e-mail address on your Team Application form.
2. Pay entry fees by due date listed
3. Complete team roster properly and legibly by printing or typing. Incomplete player information may result in a player being deemed ineligible to play.
4. Notify team players and sponsors of insurance and liability.
5. Be familiar with and understand all rules and regulations and to be sure that your team members are also informed.
